

RESOLUTION OF THE TOWNSHIP COUNCIL OF THE TOWNSHIP OF MOUNT OLIVE SUPPORTING THE FINDINGS OF THE NEW JERSEY DEPARTMENT OF TRANSPORTATION THAT ROUTE 206 SHOULD BE A “NO PASSING” ZONE THROUGH THE ENTIRE LENGTH OF MOUNT OLIVE TOWNSHIP

WHEREAS, the Township has received a letter from the New Jersey Department of Transportation that indicates they have reviewed the passing zones that exist on Route 206 and have recommended changing the centerline markings to eliminate the passing zones. Upon review of this information and the area, the Mount Olive Township Police Department concurs with the finding.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Township of Mount Olive supports the finding of the New Jersey Department of Transportation which indicates the centerline markings on Route 206 should be changed to eliminate centerline passing zones within the Township. This change will cause the entire length of Route 206 within the Township to be a "No Passing" zone.
