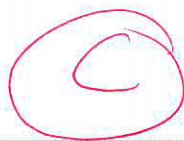

Save Mount Olive *Volunteer* Emergency Medical Services



After more than a half a century of responding to needs of their sick, hurt and scared neighbors, the mayor wants to eliminate these proud services to save what he estimates is \$250,000 a year and replace them with a paid service that would charge users more than \$400 each time they need an ambulance. The \$250,000 budget for these two squads totals less than \$10/year/person for state-of-the-art professional EMS and other services. The Town Council will vote on the mayor's proposal on Jan. 19 unless you stop them. Call Town Hall (973-691-0900) or email theTown Council members today and tell them you support Mt. Olive's rescue squads and they should too.
