

RESOLUTION OF THE TOWNSHIP COUNCIL OF THE TOWNSHIP OF MOUNT OLIVE AUTHORIZING A CONTRACT WITH WALKER DIVING FOR THE CLEANING OF THE CLOVERHILL TREATMENT PLANT AERATION TANK UNDER THE “NON-FAIR AND OPEN” CONTRACTS IN ACCORDANCE WITH THE PAY-TO-PLAY LAW

WHEREAS, the Cloverhill Treatment Plant Aeration Tank is in need of cleaning of the build-up of grit materials that have settled in the base of the tank; and

WHEREAS, the Township had previously bid the project on two separate occasions with no bid submissions, therefore prompting the need to request quotes; and

WHEREAS, due to the sensitive nature of this project and the requirement that the facility remains operational only two quotes were obtained; and

WHEREAS, Tim Quinn, DPW Director received quotes from two vendors with Walker Diving submitting the lowest quote of \$109,800 for cleaning and disposal of a maximum of 50 cubic yards and \$16,850.00 per day in excess of the maximum allowed; and

WHEREAS, the entire project cost will not exceed \$120,000.00; and

WHEREAS, under the “non-fair and open” provisions of N.J.S.A. 19:44A-20.4 or 20.5 as appropriate the vendor has completed and submitted a Business Entity Disclosure Certification which certifies they have not made any reportable contributions to a political or candidate committee in Mount Olive in the previous one year, and that the contract will prohibit them from making any reportable contributions through the term of the contract; and

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED by the Township Council of the Township of Mount Olive that it does hereby authorize the Mayor to execute a contract with Walker Diving with the Township of Mount Olive as described herein; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Business Disclosure Entity Certification and the Determination of Value to be placed on file with this resolution.
