

**RESOLUTION OF THE TOWNSHIP COUNCIL OF THE TOWNSHIP OF
MOUNT OLIVE AUTHORIZING AN AGREEMENT WITH THE MOUNT
OLIVE TOWNSHIP HISTORICAL SOCIETY TO USE OFFICE SPACE AT THE
BLUE ATLAS BUILDING AT BLOCK 4500 LOT 8**

WHEREAS, The Mount Olive Township Historical Society was founded as a 501c3 charitable organization to discover, research, collect, and preserve the historic legacy of the Township of Mount Olive; and

WHEREAS, under the guidance and dedication of Township Historian Thea Dunkle and the many members of the Society, the Society has worked on many projects and raised public awareness and support regarding the history of Mount Olive; and

WHEREAS, the Mount Olive Township Historical Society is in need of a home base of operations to continue their work and store their collections and research projects; and

WHEREAS, a proposal made by the Mount Olive Township Historical Society regarding terms of use of the building has been discussed and endorsed by the Mayor and Township Council.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED by the Township Council of the Township of Mount Olive that it does hereby authorize an agreement with the Mount Olive Township Historical Society to lease two rooms in the Blue Atlas building at Block 4500 Lot 8 to be used as a headquarters for the organization.
