

**RESOLUTION OF THE TOWNSHIP COUNCIL OF THE TOWNSHIP
OF MOUNT OLIVE AUTHORIZING MT. OLIVE SOCCER CLUB &
MT. OLIVE JR. MARAUDER FOOTBALL ASSOCIATION TO
DEVELOP PRACTICE FIELDS AT TURKEY BROOK PARK**

WHEREAS, the Mt. Olive Soccer Club has specifically applied to the Township Council to develop (3) three soccer practice fields at Turkey Brook Park, in accordance to the initial plans for developing the park (which was to be done at a later phase), at no cost to the township; and

WHEREAS, the Mt. Olive Soccer Club also presented said plans to the Recreation Advisory Committee; and

WHEREAS, Mt. Olive Jr. Marauders Football Association proposed to develop the fourth practice field as shown on the initial Turkey Brook Park plans in the same scope of work as arranged for by Mt. Olive Soccer Club, as recommended by the Recreation Advisory Committee, at no cost to the Township; and

WHEREAS, it is understood that once these practice fields are developed at Turkey Brook Park, on Township owned property, they become the property of the Township.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Township Council of Mt. Olive as follows:

1. The Mt. Olive Soccer Club and Mt. Olive Jr. Marauders Football Association are authorized to develop practice fields at Turkey Brook Park, in the location as specified in the initial plans for the park development, as presented to the Township Council and Recreation Advisory Committee.
2. These practice fields are to be used to allow the other soccer fields and football field to rest, or be renovated.
3. No additional parking lots are to be developed for the practice fields, thereby maintaining the number of users/vehicles in the park as it currently accommodates.
4. The scheduling of the use of the practice fields will be in accordance with current Recreation Department policies and procedures as well as the determination of field closures by the Supervisor of Parks, Buildings & Grounds.
5. These fields will be open to the general public when not in use by a permitted, scheduled group, provided they are not in need of renovation.
