

**RESOLUTION OF THE TOWNSHIP COUNCIL OF
THE TOWNSHIP OF MOUNT OLIVE AUTHORIZING
A CHANGE ORDER WITH DAVE BOGART FOR STABILIZATION
OF THE SEWARD HOUSE**

WHEREAS, the Township is the owner of a historic mansion known as the Seward House and the status of this house is that a Certificate of Eligibility for the National Register of Historic Places has been issued; and

WHEREAS, the structure has been inspected by qualified architects and/or engineers who have determined that the structure is in need of continued stabilization in preparation for a replacement roof; and

WHEREAS, due to the discovery of an immediate need for specific repairs, and

WHEREAS, the Township has funds available from the Open Space Trust Fund for the stabilization of this building which will require the following expenditure: A change order in the amount of \$5,000 for Dave Bogert, professional contractor at a rate of \$65.00 and a helper at a rate of \$45.00; and

WHEREAS, the work must be completed before the roof can be replaced and the building enclosed.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Township Council of the Township of Mount Olive that the Mayor of Mount Olive Township is hereby authorized to execute the necessary change order to complete the stabilization work.
