WPCS International Incorporated - \$26,964.45

WHEREAS, the contract is to be awarded pursuant to the "Fair and Open" process as required under the Pay-to-Play legislation NJSA 19:44A-20.7; and

WHEREAS, the Chief Financial Officer has provided a certification that the funds for this purchase are available.
