

RESOLUTION OF THE TOWNSHIP COUNCIL OF THE TOWNSHIP OF MOUNT OLIVE AUTHORIZING A PROFESSIONAL SERVICES AGREEMENT WITH PRINCETON HYDRO, LLC FOR SERVICES IN CONNECTION WITH THE REMEDIATION AND CONTROL OF THE WEEDS IN BUDD LAKE

WHEREAS, the Township has investigated the need to remediate and control the weeds growing in Budd Lake; and

WHEREAS, after such investigation was conducted by the Township it has been both requested and recommended by the Township that a professional services agreement be entered into for work which is needed and is necessary for control of the lake's weed problems including a qualitative survey and assessment of the Lake, collection and qualitative analysis, development and assistance in review of bid specifications and preparation of a NJDEP Pesticide Control Program permit application; and

WHEREAS, Princeton Hydro, LLC, has provided the Township with a proposal dated October 6, 2008, a copy of which is attached hereto; and

WHEREAS, the Township wishes to proceed with this project as outlined in Princeton Hydro LLC's proposal to begin the engineering services to control the weeds growing in Budd Lake; and

WHEREAS, funds are available for this purpose from the Open Space Trust; and

WHEREAS, the Local Public Contracts Law (N.J.S.A. 40A:11-1, et seq.) requires that the resolution authorizing the award of contracts for "professional services" without competitive bid and the contract itself must be made available for public inspection.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Township Council of the Township of Mount Olive, in the County of Morris, State of New Jersey, that a contract is hereby awarded to Princeton Hydro, LLC, as outlined in its proposal dated October 6, 2008; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that this contract is awarded without competitive bidding, as the services to be provided are professional in nature.
