Dear Mayor:

Yesterday, Governor Corzine signed the Qualified Purchasing Agent (QPA) bill, with the conditional veto language, into law as P.L. 2009, c. 166.

The new law will:

- Make the appointment of a QPA **permissive**.
- Set a local unit's bid threshold at \$17,500 unless they appoint a QPA. This is the same threshold in the Pay-to-Play law.
- Allow the Division of Local Government Services a year to implement the process to obtain a QPA certification.
