

**RESOLUTION OF THE TOWNSHIP COUNCIL OF THE
TOWNSHIP OF MOUNT OLIVE ESTABLISHING THE TEMPORARY
ADOPTION OF VILLET TV SOMERVILLE TELEVISION STATION POLICIES
AND PROCEDURES UNTIL SUCH TIME THAT A MOUNT OLIVE SPECIFIC
POLICY/PROCEDURE DOCUMENT IS FINALIZED AND ADOPTED**

WHEREAS, the township administration and the board of education administration has successfully worked together with area cable TV providers Cablevision and Verizon FIOS to establish Educational and Governmental TV channel access expressly for use by Mount Olive Township according to their respective cable system franchises; and

WHEREAS, the dedicated channel connectivity has been installed and completed from the Mt Olive High School TV Studio and Equipment location to the respective cable providers for transmission on Channel 21 via Cablevision and Channel 32 via Verizon FIOS; and

WHEREAS, it is appropriate to have in place a documented set of Television Station Policies and Procedures for Mount Olive's Educational & Governmental (E & G) channels; and

WHEREAS, recognizing that it will take some time to develop a specific Mount Olive policy document, the township administrator Bill Sohl and School Superintendent Dr. Reynolds recommend temporary adoption by reference of the "VilleTV Somerville (NJ) Educational and Governmental Television Station Policies & Procedures" document during an interim period until a specific Mt Olive Township Policies & Procedures document can be drafted, reviewed and adopted by both the township council and the board of education.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Township Council of the Township of Mount Olive, in the County of Morris, State of New Jersey, that it does hereby authorize the temporary adoption by reference of the "VilleTV, Somerville (NJ) Educational and Governmental Television Station Policies and Procedures" to govern the use of Mount Olive's Educational & Governmental TV station channels for Cablevision Channel 21 and Verizon FIOS Channel 32 until a Mount Olive specific policy/procedures document is adopted.
