DIRECTIONS TO CHERRY HILL TOWN HALL

From Ben Franklin Bridge, Philadelphia

Take Ben Franklin Bridge to Admiral Wilson Blvd. (Rt. 30 East).

Follow 30 East to **Rt. 70 East** for Cherry Hill/Marlton.

Continue on Route 70 East for approximately two miles..

Pass the Cherry Hill Holiday Inn (on right) and **exit** just before Mercedes-Benz of Cherry Hill for **Haddonfield Road/Grove St.**

This street dead ends into **Park Blvd. Turn left on Park** and continue to the first light.

Turn left at the light onto Grove St./Haddonfield Rd. and proceed to cross over Route 70.

From the right lane, go through the light at Land Rover Cherry Hill

(Wynwood Ave.) and proceed to **make the fourth right (Graham Ave.)**

From Graham, **turn left onto Mercer Street.** The Municipal Building is on the right (820 Mercer Street).

From Interstate 295 - North & South

Take **Exit 34B** for Rt. 70 West (Cherry Hill-Camden).

Proceed on Rt. 70 West for about 2.5 miles or through 4 traffic lights.

Before the fifth light (Haddonfield Road), **turn right onto Mercer St.** (just after Cherry Hill Volvo, gas station on corner).

Travel approximately four blocks and the Municipal Building is on the right.

From New Jersey Turnpike - North & South

Take **Exit 4** for Rt. 73 North.

Proceed on Route 73 North for less than a half mile to Interstate 295 South (exit to the right).

From I-295 South, take **Exit 34B** for Rt. 70 West (Cherry Hill-Camden).

Proceed on Rt. 70 West for about 2.5 miles or through 4 traffic signals.

Before the fifth light (Haddonfield Road), **turn right onto Mercer St.** (just after Cherry Hill Volvo, gas station on corner).

Travel approximately four blocks and the Municipal Building is on the right.

Public Transportation**NJ Transit 405 Bus**

Get off at the corner of Haddonfield and Chapel Roads.

Walk down Haddonfield Road four blocks to Graham Avenue.

Make a left and walk one block to Mercer Street.

NJ Transit 406 Bus

Get off at the corner of Haddonfield Road (after the light) and Route 70.

Cross the street.

Walk four blocks north on Haddonfield Road.

Make a right onto Graham Avenue.

Walk one block to Mercer Street.

NJ Transit Rail

Take the Atlantic City Rail Line from 30th Street Station in Philadelphia or out of Atlantic City.

Get off at Garden State Pavilions/Garden State Park.

Reach 820 Mercer St. via cab, or walk across the Garden State Park

Marketplace shopping center and cross Haddonfield Road at a crosswalk.

Proceed down any cross street (Graham, Severn, Sherwood, Wynwood) to

Mercer Street.
