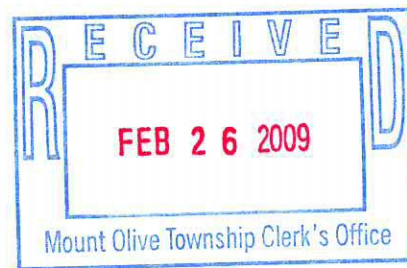

The New Jersey Department of Environmental Protection (Department) acknowledges receipt on October 16, 2008 of the Site Investigation Report submitted pursuant to the Underground Storage Tank regulations at N.J.A.C. 7:14B (UST Rule) and the Technical Requirements for Site Remediation at N.J.A.C. 7:26E (Tech Rule).

Deficiencies

The Department has completed its review of your submittal and identified the following deficiencies:

Failure to pay the required fee. As of October 1, 2007, the review fee for a Site Investigation report (SIR) for the removal of an underground storage tank in which no discharge of a hazardous substance has occurred is \$750. The Department is in receipt of the \$500 check submitted with the SIR.

Failure to submit an amended UST Questionnaire to reflect changes in status made to the UST systems. Specifically, the Department's registration does not indicate the size of the three underground storage tanks that were previously on site.

Corrective Actions

To correct these deficiencies please take the following actions or make the required submittals within the timeframes indicated:


Pursuant to N.J.A.C. 7:14B-3, submit the required additional \$250 fee within 60 days after receipt of this notice. Please make a check payable to Treasurer, State of New Jersey.

Pursuant to N.J.A.C. 7:14B-2.2(f), submit an updated Underground Storage Tank Facility Certification Questionnaire form to reflect the correct sizes and contents of the previously removed tanks within 60 days after receipt of this notice.

Note that if deficiencies included herein are not addressed to the Department's satisfaction within the specified time period the Department will consider them to be violations and may assess penalties pursuant to N.J.A.C. 7:26C-10.
