Nutrition Site In Roxbury Moves To New Home

The Morris County Midday Friendship Center nutrition site for senior citizens in Roxbury is moving to a new home.

The Center, operated by the Morris County Nutrition Program, is leaving the Old Lafayette School on Berkshire Valley & Mill roads for a township building at 72 Eyland Ave. that also houses the Roxbury Senior Center.
