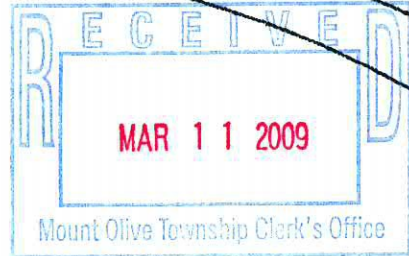

RE: NFL Network

I am writing to advise you of the status of our carriage of the NFL Network, which is one of the channels contained in our Sports Entertainment Package. Comcast's signal carriage agreement with the NFL Network (cable channels 180, 218 and 275) expires shortly. We are currently negotiating with the National Football League to reach a fair agreement for all concerned parties, especially our customers. By law, Comcast is not allowed to continue to carry the station without its owner's permission. If, despite our best efforts, we are unable to reach a reasonable agreement and our right to carry the NFL Network (cable channels 180, 218 and 275) ends, Comcast may be required by law to suspend carriage of the signal as early as May 1. Please know that I will keep you informed of the status of the NFL Network, but feel free to call me with any questions.
