

**RESOLUTION OF THE TOWNSHIP COUNCIL OF THE
TOWNSHIP OF MOUNT OLIVE AUTHORIZING THE USE OF
COMPETITIVE CONTRACTING FOR EMERGENCY MEDICAL
AND TRANSPORTATION SERVICES**

WHEREAS, the Township wishes to solicit proposals from vendors for emergency medical and transportation services; and

WHEREAS, N.J.S.A. 40A:11-4.1 of the Local Public Contract Law permits the use of “competitive contracting” in lieu of public bidding for the procurement of specialized goods and services, including the operation, management or administration of such services as may be approved by the Director of the Division of Local Government Services in the Department of Community Affairs; and

WHEREAS, any contract for emergency medical and transportation services shall be awarded by resolution of the Township Council based on the most advantageous price and other factors to be considered by the Township, including the experience and qualifications of the parties submitting proposals for the required services.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED by the Township Council of the Township of Mount Olive that it does hereby authorize the Township to use the “competitive contracting” procedures set forth in N.J.S.A. 40A:11-4.1 et seq. to solicit proposals to provide emergency medical and transportation services.
