FOR BUDD LAKE HERBICIDE-BASED WEED CONTROL PROGRAM**

**WHEREAS**, the lake is in need of a weed control program for 2009 and the Mayor and Council provided funding for this purchase; and

**WHEREAS**, the Township duly advertised for bids on March 5, 2009 and bids were opened on March 17, 2009 and the following bid(s) were received and publicly opened:

**Cost for Entire Lake Treatment**  
Allied Biological - \$44,894.60  
Aquatic Technologies - \$38,877.30  
Aquatic Analysts - \$65,000.00

**WHEREAS**, Steve Souza of Princeton Hydro has reviewed the bid submittals and proposes that the Township treat the entire lake; and

**WHEREAS**, the using Department Head / Staff and the Business Administrator have also reviewed the bids and recommended award to the lowest responsible bidder; and

**WHEREAS**, the Chief Financial Officer has provided a certification that the funds for this purchase are available.

**WHEREAS**, this contract has been advertised and awarded on a "fair and open basis" and nothing further shall be required under the Pay-to-Play legislation (N.J.S.A. 19:44A-20.7)

**NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED** by the Township Council of the Township of Mount Olive, Morris County, that the bid of Aquatic Technologies in the amount of \$38,877.30 in accordance the specifications dated March 5, 2009 is hereby accepted and the Mayor is authorized to execute the necessary contracts to implement this bid award.
