LANDOWNER NOTIFICATION

FirstEnergy's Transmission lines provide power to thousands of electric customers and are vital reliability links with other utilities across the country. Maintaining Transmission rights-of-way that are free of certain types of vegetation is a very important part of providing reliable and safe electric service. Your cooperation in accomplishing our vegetation management work will be greatly appreciated.

Vegetation Management work is being scheduled for your property in the near future. This work may involve controlling large and small trees that are interfering or have the potential to interfere with the operation and maintenance of the transmission facilities. Trees that are adjacent to the right-of-way that are unhealthy, leaning, or encroaching the right-of-way may also require work. It may also involve the clearing of lower growing vegetation. This work will enable safe access to our lines and structures for routine inspection and maintenance work as well as emergency restoration efforts.

FirstEnergy has engaged vegetation-clearing contractors to assist in this effort. FirstEnergy's contractors will use power saws, EPA approved herbicides, mechanical equipment or a combination of each.

A Work Planner from Davey Resource Group has prescribed the work specific to your property and is attempting to contact you regarding this work.

Even though our easements generally provide sufficient rights for the work that is planned, we want to be certain that you are aware of this work and acknowledge reviewing it with a work planner. The Work Planner will use either an Orange door card or a Work Plan to communicate and document the work that will be done on your property. Therefore, by signing that information it will help us ensure that we have communicated the work to you.
