**AN ORDINANCE OF THE TOWNSHIP OF MOUNT OLIVE
TO AMEND AND SUPPLEMENT ORDINANCE NO. 14-2008
ENTITLED “AN ORDINANCE OF THE TOWNSHIP OF
MOUNT OLIVE TO AMEND AND SUPPLEMENT
VARIOUS PORTIONS OF THE MOUNT OLIVE
TOWNSHIP CODE DEALING WITH SOLID WASTE AND
RECYCLING”**

WHEREAS, the Township recognizes that a clerical error was made in Section 13 of Ordinance No. 14-2008.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the Township Council of the Township of Mount Olive, County of Morris, and State of New Jersey:

SECTION 1. Section 13 of Ordinance No. 14-2008 entitled “AN ORDINANCE OF THE TOWNSHIP OF MOUNT OLIVE TO AMEND AND SUPPLEMENT VARIOUS PORTIONS OF THE MOUNT OLIVE TOWNSHIP CODE DEALING WITH SOLID WASTE AND RECYCLING” is hereby amended to read as follows:

Section 13. Section 211-24. Stickers required.

Section 211-24 entitled Stickers required within Article V is hereby amended and supplemented to provide for as follows:

“Township residents shall be required to obtain a sticker from the Township Department of Public Works in order to dispose of a large item or to have tire collection done at their residence. The fees for these stickers shall be as follows:

- (1) Large items, excluding those containing Freon: \$10 to \$20 per item; Freon items: \$15.
- (2) Other large items: \$5 per item.
- (3) Household trash dumpster: \$260 per pickup.
- (4) Additional garbage container/bag: \$2 per item.
- (5) Propane tank disposal: \$10.
- (6) Tires: \$2 per tire.

Residents requesting a sticker can purchase it at the Department of Public Works or request an application for the same through the mail or from the Township website. Stickers may also be available at times from other locations (e.g. local stores) as may be identified on the Township website.

The collection of "other large items," tires and "large items" will not occur until the resident has purchased the appropriate sticker. The sticker must be affixed to the item to

be collected prior to its collection and placed curbside.”

SECTION 2. This ordinance shall take affect in accordance with law and subject to the appropriate signage.
