I am pleased to announce that the New Jersey Department of Transportation (NJDOT) is now accepting applications for the Transportation Enhancement ARRA (Economic Recovery) Program.

The Transportation Enhancement Program provides communities with funding for non-traditional transportation projects that enhance the cultural, aesthetic, historic, and environmental aspects of the State's transportation system. This year's Transportation Enhancement Program will receive funding through the recently enacted American Recovery and Reinvestment Act. The Department is seeking construction-ready projects that will have complete Plans, Specification, Estimates and all related documents submitted no later than January 4, 2010. All projects must be authorized for funds by March 2, 2010 or risk losing project funds. The online Transportation Enhancement brochure provides the necessary information for completing your application and also answers questions regarding eligibility and program requirements. Please feel free to share this information with other governmental agencies and non-profit civic groups in your community. As with all federally funded programs, the funds will be disbursed on a reimbursement basis.
