

**RESOLUTION OF THE TOWNSHIP COUNCIL OF THE TOWNSHIP OF
MOUNT OLIVE AWARDING A CONTRACT TO ATLANTIC AMBULANCE
CORPORATION FOR EMERGENCY MEDICAL SERVICES AND MEDICAL
TRANSPORTATION SERVICES**

WHEREAS, Mount Olive Township is in need of emergency medical services and medical transportation services; and

WHEREAS, the Township duly advertised for bids on March 30, 2009 and bids were opened on April 14, 2009 and the following bid(s) were received and publicly opened:

Emergency Transportation Service Billed to Patient
Atlantic Ambulance Corporation - \$450.00/per patient
Saint Clare's Hospital, Inc. - \$400.00/per patient

WHEREAS, upon review of the bid submittals it has been determined that Saint Clare's Hospital, Inc. failed to provide their New Jersey Business Registration Certificate which is deemed a fatal defect and shall render the bid proposal unresponsive as per NJSA 40A:11-23.2; and

WHEREAS, the Public Safety Committee and the Business Administrator have reviewed the bids and recommend award to the Atlantic Ambulance Corporation; and

WHEREAS, this contract has been advertised and awarded on a "fair and open basis" and nothing further shall be required under the Pay-to-Play legislation (N.J.S.A. 19:44A-20.7)

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Township Council of the Township of Mount Olive, Morris County, that the bid of Atlantic Ambulance Corporation in accordance with the specifications dated March 30, 2009 is hereby accepted and the Mayor is authorized to execute the necessary contracts to implement this bid award.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that a certified copy of this resolution be provided to the Township Business Administrator for implementation.
