## NOTICE OF PUBLIC HEARING

### NOTICE TO THE RESIDENTS OF THE TOWNSHIP OF MOUNT OLIVE AND OTHER INTERESTED PARTIES

#### **IN THE MATTER OF THE PETITION OF APPLIED WASTEWATER MANAGEMENT, INC. FOR APPROVAL OF MUNICIPAL CONSENT GRANTED BY THE TOWNSHIP OF MOUNT OLIVE, MORRIS COUNTY; AND EXTENSION OF ITS EXISTING WATER TARIFF TO THE NEW SERVICE AREA BPU DOCKET NO. WE09030185**

**PLEASE TAKE NOTICE**, that on or about March 5, 2009 Applied Wastewater Management Inc. (“AWWM” or “Petitioner”) filed a Petition with the New Jersey Board of Public Utilities (“Board”) requesting that the Board issue an order approving Ordinance No. 42-2008 adopted by the Township of Mount Olive Council on August 18, 2008. This municipal consent ordinance was introduced and adopted pursuant to N.J.S.A. 19:17, *et seq.* in order to permit and authorize AWWM to own, operate and maintain a water supply system, including but not limited to, facilities such as wells, mains, treatment facilities, storage tanks, service pipes, hydrants, valves, well house, driveways and the appurtenances (the “Water Supply System”) in a portion of the Township. The Water Supply System will provide potable water service to a new, yet to be constructed development in the Township of Mount Olive commonly referred to as Morris Chase. AWWM currently owns and operates potable water supply and wastewater systems in the community commonly referred to as “Country Oaks”, also located in the Township of Mount Olive.

AWWM is a regulated public utility corporation engaged in operating sewage collection, treatment and disposal systems in the Borough of Bloomsbury; the Township of Union; the Township of Tewksbury; the Township of Clinton, all in Hunterdon County; the Township of Mt. Olive; the Township of Chester; the Township of Jefferson, all in Morris County; the Township of Mansfield, in Burlington County; the Township of Upper Freehold, in Monmouth County; Middle Township, in Cape May County; the Township of Washington, in Warren County; the Township of Oakland, in Bergen County; and the Township of Hillsborough, in Somerset County; and potable water systems in the Township of Chester and the Township of Mount Olive, both in Morris County; and the Township of Tewksbury, in Hunterdon County; as a regulated public utility under the jurisdiction of the Board of Public Utilities. Within its service territory, Petitioner serves approximately 4,100 customers.

Approval of the Ordinance submitted to the Board with the Petition will serve the public interest by permitting AWWM to extend its service territory in order to provide potable water service to an area within the Township of Mount Olive. Extension of the franchise territory is necessary and proper for the public convenience and to properly serve the public interest.

The rates to be charged by AWWM are those set forth in its tariff.
