Over the last year the State has started a variety of initiatives that enable local government agencies to reduce their energy usage, increase their clean energy usage and gain the cost and environmental benefits that comes from this improved and cleaner energy usage. These efforts are aligned with the Governor's Energy Master Plan.

New and enhanced financial incentives for installing energy efficient equipment and conservation measures, incentives for renewable energy facilities, financing for capital improvements, rebates for energy audits, and technical assistance are some of the new resources available to municipal governments.
