You are hereby NOTIFIED that during a compliance evaluation at the above location on 05/18/2009, the following violation(s) of the Flood Hazard Area Control Act (N.J.S.A. 58:16A-50 et seq.) and the regulations (N.J.A.C. 7:13-1.1 et seq.) was observed.

- a. **Requirement:** Pursuant to N.J.A.C. 7:13-2.1(a), no person shall engage in a regulated activity in a regulated area without a flood hazard area permit as required by this chapter, or a coastal permit as required by N.J.A.C. 7:7 and 7:7E. [N.J.A.C. 7:13-2.1(a)]
- Description of Noncompliance:** The performance of unauthorized regulated activities within a regulated area without the required permit authorization. The regulated activities include the unauthorized clearing of vegetation, placement of soil and wood chip fill material, and the disturbance of soil within approximately 8,000 square feet of the riparian buffer associated with the Musconetcong River.

ALL UNAUTHORIZED ACTIVITIES MUST CEASE IMMEDIATELY.

You must take the following corrective actions:

- a. Submit within 20 calendar days of receipt of this document an application to the Department's Division of Land Use Regulation for the appropriate permit authorization or a restoration plan to the Bureau to restore the site to its predisturbance condition.

X *If land or vegetation has been disturbed, immediately contact the local Soil Conservation District and implement appropriate soil and sediment control measures to prevent degradation of water resources.*

Within 10 calendar days of receipt of this Notice of Violation, you shall submit in writing to David Sumba, an explanation of the corrective measures you have taken or will take to achieve compliance.

This **Notice of Violation** serves as notice that the NJDEP, Bureau of Coastal and Land Use Compliance and Enforcement, has determined that a violation has occurred. It does not constitute final agency action and may not be appealed or contested. The issuance of this Notice or compliance therewith does not preclude the State of New Jersey or any of its agencies from initiating formal administrative and/or judicial enforcement action (including assessment of penalties), with respect to the violations listed above or for any other violations. You **may** appeal or contest such formal actions. Penalties may be assessed on a daily basis.
