

**RESOLUTION OF THE TOWNSHIP COUNCIL OF THE
TOWNSHIP OF MOUNT OLIVE AUTHORIZING THE SUBMITTAL
AND ACCEPTANCE OF A GRANT FOR THE
“OVER THE LIMIT UNDER ARREST 2009 STATEWIDE CRACKDOWN”**

WHEREAS, impaired drivers on our nation’s roads kill someone every 30 minutes, 50 people per day, and almost 18,000 people each year; and

WHEREAS, 34% of motor vehicle fatalities in New Jersey are alcohol-related; and

WHEREAS, an enforcement crackdown is planned to combat impaired driving; and

WHEREAS, the summer season and the Labor Day Holiday are traditionally times of social gatherings which often include alcohol; and

WHEREAS, the State of New Jersey, Division of Highway Traffic Safety, has asked law enforcement agencies throughout the state to participate in the “Over the Limit Under Arrest 2008 Impaired Driving Crackdown”; and

WHEREAS, the project will involve increased impaired driving enforcement from August 21 – September 7, 2009; and

WHEREAS, an increase in impaired driving enforcement and a reduction in impaired driving will save lives on our roadways.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED by the Township Council of the Township of Mount Olive that it does hereby authorize the submittal and acceptance of the “Over the Limit Under Arrest 2009 Statewide Crackdown” grant.
