**ORD. # 7 - 2008**

**AN ORDINANCE OF THE TOWNSHIP OF MOUNT OLIVE TO ADJUST  
WATER RATES AND SERVICE FEES**

**WHEREAS**, the Township Ordinance provides that the Township's Water Utility shall be self-liquidating, i.e. revenues will match expenditures; and

**WHEREAS**, the Township last adjusted its water rates in 2002, by way of Ordinance #29-2002, adopted July 9, 2002; and

**WHEREAS**, the Township has reviewed its existing water rates and determined that modest increases are needed to maintain the Water Utility on a self-liquidating basis; and

**NOW THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED** by the Township Council of the Township of Mount Olive, County of Morris, as follows:

**Section 1. Residential Rates**

A. Actual metered. Residential consumers of water, except garden apartment consumers, which are subject to § 196-141, shall be charged quarterly on an actual metered basis at the following rates:

- (1) Up to 7,500 gallons (flat fee): \$35.00 per quarter for services rendered on or after the second quarter 2008. [Amended 7-9-2002 by Ord. No. 29-2002].
- (2) Seven Thousand Five Hundred gallons to 22,500 gallons: \$1.90 per 1,000 gallons.
- (3) Twenty-two Thousand Five Hundred gallons to 37,500: \$2.60 per 1000 gallons.
- (4) Thirty-seven Thousand Five Hundred gallons and up: \$3.60 per 1000 gallons.

B. Unmetered. Those consumers supplied by Township water systems which are unmetered shall be charged a quarterly flat fee of \$68.00 per quarter for services rendered on or after the second quarter 2008.

**Section 2. Commercial and Industrial Rates**

A. Commercial and industrial consumers of water, including schools shall be charged on an actual metered basis at the following rates for services rendered on or after the second quarter 2008:

**Section 3. Garden Apartment Rates**


A. The water rates for garden apartments, per unit, shall be based on an average meter calculation. Said average meter calculation shall be determined by dividing the total quarterly usage for the entire development by the number of units (determined by certificates of occupancy issued).

B. The rate schedule per unit for services rendered on or after the second quarter 2008 shall be as follows:

- (1) Up to 7,500 gallons (dollars per 1,000 gallons) \$41.00 flat fee.
- (2) Seven Thousand Five Hundred to 22,500 gallons - \$1.90 per 1,000 gallons.
- (3) Twenty-two Thousand Five Hundred gallons and up - \$2.45 per 1,000 gallons.

Section 4. This ordinance shall take effect for all bills issued after April 1, 2008.


