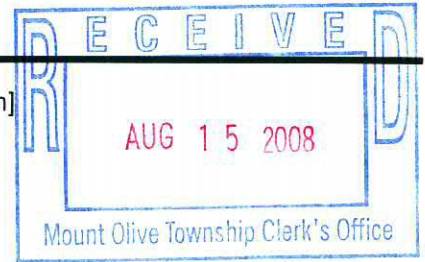

Dear Mayor:		
We would like to draw your attention to some important new information on the website of the Division of Local Government Services.		
1. State Fiscal Year municipalities considering applying for Extraordinary Aid for FY 2009 should review Local Finance Notice 2008-14. (www.nj.gov/dca/lgs/lfns/08lfns/2008-14.doc) Applications and the introduced budget, AFS and the 2007 audit report must be filed with the Division by September 19, 2008.		
2. The CY 2008/FY 2009 State Aid Payment and Recapitulation Form is now available on the DLGS website. Local Finance Notice 2008-13 (www.nj.gov/dca/lgs/lfns/08lfns/2008-13.doc) describes changes and dates for aid payments this year. The direct link for your municipality's payments can be found at the following location: www.state.nj.us/dca/lgs/muniaid/08_aid/08ars/menu_ars_2008.shtml .		

3 . Governor Corzine has signed into law the "Statewide Non-Residential Development Fee Act," which imposes a 2.5 percent development fee on all non-residential new construction and additions. The fee took effect on certificates of occupancy issued on and after July 18. Pursuant to the Act a certificate of occupancy cannot be issued without the fee being paid.
