On behalf of Bartley-Chester Road, Inc., I am writing to inform you that we will soon begin work to investigate environmental contamination at the **Former NJ Bus Company/Laidlaw Transit, 704 Bartley-Chester Road, Mt. Olive Twsp. Morris Cty, tax block 6800 and lot 14.** The work will be done under rules established by the New Jersey Department of Environmental Protection (DEP), which has assigned it case number 88-11-21-0100.

The investigation is prompted by the presence of Benzene, Methyl tert-butyl ether (MTBE), Tert-butyl alcohol (TBA), Tetrachloroethene, Total Tentatively Identified Compounds (TICs) which have been found in the groundwater. Our work will involve additional soil and groundwater investigations to evaluate the vertical extent of gasoline contamination and the source & extent of Tetrachloroethene impacting groundwater.

During the course of the work, we will provide you with periodic updates about our progress. A copy of any and all of our reports regarding the work will also be made available to Mt. Olive Township officials, upon request. Should you have any questions regarding the work, you can contact me directly at 973-838-5844 and I will be happy to answer any questions you may have.
