

**RESOLUTION OF THE TOWNSHIP COUNCIL OF THE TOWNSHIP
OF MOUNT OLIVE AUTHORIZING THE RETURN OF ONE (1) EDU
ASSIGNED TO BLOCK 2507 LOT 1 FOR A REDUCTION IN THE SEWER
ASSESSMENT ANNUAL CHARGE AND QUARTERLY USER FEES
(The Rose House)**

WHEREAS, Block 2507 Lot 1 was originally assessed for three (3) EDU's as part of the Budd Lake Sewer Assessment program under the premise that the property owner could build on all three (3) of their lots; and

WHEREAS, the property owner has determined that the Highlands Act restrictions do not permit him to build a third home under the new regulations; and

WHEREAS, the property owner is requesting that the Township allow him to return one (1) EDU thereby reducing the sewer assessment bill and user fees to.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED by the Township Council of the Township of Mount Olive that it does hereby authorize the return of one (1) EDU for Block 2507 Lot 1, thereby reducing the sewer assessment annual charge and quarterly user fees.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Tax Collector is hereby authorized to reduce the sewer assessment fee and user fees to two (2) EDU's and make the necessary adjustments to the account of Block 2507 Lot 1.
