RESOLUTION OF THE MAYOR AND BOARD OF ALDERMEN OF THE TOWN OF BOONTON, COUNTY OF MORRIS, STATE OF NEW JERSEY, OPPOSING THE PROPOSED CHANGES TO THE HEALTH CARE SYSTEM

WHEREAS, the members of Congress are currently considering changes to the health care system; and

WHEREAS, communities such as the Town of Boonton will be required to start to pay healthcare benefits for part-time employees; and

WHEREAS, the impact of such changes would require the Town of Boonton to either increase property taxes to pay for providing these benefits or cutting jobs and services to remain tax neutral; and

WHEREAS, the Mayor and Board of Aldermen of the Town of Boonton, in the County of Morris and State of New Jersey, are hereby vehemently opposed to these changes.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that in the event that such legislation is passed, let the legislation include the following provision: "All members of the Senate and the House of Representatives will be put in to the same health care system as the rest of the citizens of the United States."

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Clerk is hereby authorized to submit copies of this certified resolution to Barack Obama, President of the United States, Senator Frank R. Lautenberg, Senator Robert Menendez and Congressman Rodney P. Frelinghuysen, as well as to all of the municipalities in Morris County.
