Seeing the Path for the Trees: A County-wide Trails Visioning Workshop



This workshop will be a hands-on session of looking where trails are within the County, where they could and should be, and how together we can make connections that will add benefits and attractions to individual trails as they are grown into a full, County-wide network.

Join us as we brainstorm with civic leaders, County and State officials, and non-profit consultants who have worked on trail plans and are ready to clear out more brush. The Center is reserved for the entire morning, so we will have plenty of time.

Barbara Davis (moderator), Vice President, Programs, Morris Land Conservancy, will give an overview of the visioning process and how to turn land use data and good ideas into solid trail concepts.

Following the introduction, break-out groups based on a variety of interests, like location, trail uses, and partnership opportunities, will be formed. Maps, posters, and laptops with trails and land-use data will be set up, with GIS professionals from the Park Commission, County Planning, and NJ Conservation Foundation to guide us through it. Come share your vision with your colleagues and representatives of trail-making and funding organizations and agencies.

Who should attend? Municipal leaders, administrators, health/recreation officials, and open space advocates. Your town should not miss this lively gathering.
