### **LATEST INFORMATION ON MAYORS WELLNESS CAMPAIGN**

These are challenging times for local leaders in our state and around the country. That is why I want to share with you a program that can accomplish a lot of good and provide positive publicity for your community – with little or no public funds.

As many of you know, this year marks the fourth year that the New Jersey League of Municipalities has joined with the New Jersey Health Care Quality Institute in an innovative effort to fight obesity, particularly childhood obesity, in our state.

Known as the “Mayors Wellness Campaign” (MWC), the effort supports mayors as champions of community health. In just the three short years since our launch, more than half of our state’s municipalities have joined the Mayors Wellness Campaign effort. In fact, just this month the Institute of Medicine released a report saying that local leadership is imperative if we are ever to make real progress on the childhood obesity epidemic which is sweeping our nation.
