Effective August 28, 2008, "Gavel to Gavel," live coverage of the NJ Legislature, will be seen on Channel 850. Programming from *Jewelry TV* will be aired on the channel when the Legislature is not in session. Also on that date, *Sports Overflow* programming will be aired on Channel 851, and no longer available on Channel 21. A digital converter or cablecard is required to view these channels.

On August 28, 2008, the following channel changes will take place:

- **Gavel-to-Gavel** programming, formerly seen on a Local Access channel, will move to Limited Basic Channel 850.*† Gavel-to-Gavel provides live coverage of the New Jersey Senate and Assembly sessions. Jewelry TV programming will be aired when the Legislature is not in session.
- Select games from **MSG2** and **MSG Plus 2** will be moving to Expanded Service channel 851.*† Also, in Comcast of LBI, the games previously shown on Expanded Service channel 14 will move to Expanded Service channel 78.
- **Discovery Health** will be available on Basic channel 48* in Comcast of Jersey City and Expanded Service channel 82* in Comcast of Meadowlands.
