



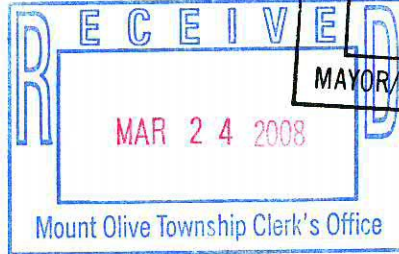
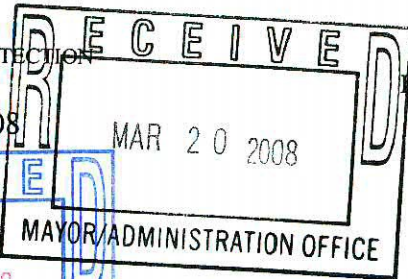

Dear Mayor Scapicchio:

I am writing to inform you that your municipality's 2008 Clean Communities entitlement is \$ 30,977.44. This information is provided to assist you as you develop your FY 2008 budget.

Twenty-one counties and five hundred fifty-nine municipalities are eligible to receive the Clean Communities Funding during 2008. The amount of the entitlement is calculated based on a total of \$14.5 million in anti-litter fees collected as of March 2008. Your town's share is based on your proportionate share of housing units and municipal road mileage. The housing unit information for the 2008 program is from the 2000 Census, as revised. The municipal road mileage amounts were provided by the New Jersey Department of Transportation.

The 2008 final payouts including allocation schedule, road mileage schedule, grant guidelines, and the New Jersey Clean Communities Council statistical reporting forms will be posted on the Council's website, www.njclean.org by the middle of May. Please check the website for those items as well as other information concerning the Clean Communities program.

We anticipate disbursing the 2008 entitlement no later than the end of April 2008. Any questions may be addressed to:
