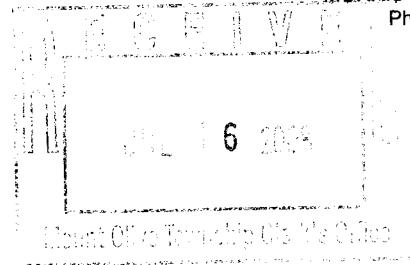

This letter is to provide legal notification pursuant to NJAC 7:7A-9.5c that the Morris County Mosquito Extermination Commission is applying to the New Jersey Department of Environmental Protection (NJDEP), Land Use Regulation Program for a countywide Freshwater Wetlands Statewide General Permit 1 and a countywide Flood Hazard Act General Permit 4.

This letter to inform you that the Morris County Mosquito Commission is submitting an application for a permit to the New Jersey Department of Environmental Protection (NJDEP) under the Freshwater Wetlands Protection Act Rules, N.J.A.C. 7:7A. The countywide permit will authorize the Morris County Mosquito Commission to conduct regulated activities in wetlands and transitional areas on properties throughout Morris County for the purpose of mosquito control.


If you would like to inspect a copy of the application, it is on file at the Municipal Clerk's Office in the town in which the property is located, or you can call the NJDEP at (609) 777-0456 to make an appointment to see the application at NJDEP offices in Trenton during normal business hours. The rules governing freshwater wetland permits and approvals are found in the NJDEP's Freshwater Wetlands Protection Act rules at N.J.A.C. 7:7A. You can view or download these rules on the NJDEP Land Use Regulation Program website at www.state.nj.us/dep/landuse, or you can find a copy of these rules in the county law library in your county courthouse. The NJDEP welcomes any comments you may have on this application. If you wish to comment on the application, comments should be submitted to the NJDEP in writing within 15 days after this letter is received. However, written comments will continue to be accepted until the NJDEP makes a decision on the application. Comments cannot be accepted by telephone.
