Gentlemen:

Notice is provided by this letter that an emergency Certificate of Public Convenience and Necessity will be issued as of the above date to Raz Transportation, LLC ("Petitioner"). Said certificate is issued pursuant to a January 25, 2008 petition for emergency and permanent authority for restricted regular route autobus operations using vans between points and places in Dover and Rockaway, Mount Olive, Wharton and Randolph, New Jersey. Emergency operations may begin temporarily for the public interest, provided that Petitioner maintains proper insurance for the vehicles used in the service and provided all vehicles pass required New Jersey Motor Vehicle Commission ("Commission") inspections. N.J.A.C. 16-51-3.4.

Emergency service is to be provided for the following regular routes:

NJMVC Regular Route File No. 1341(A) – Dover – Rockaway

NJMVC Regular Route File No. 1341(B) – Dover – Mount Olive

NJMVC Regular Route File No. 1341(A) – Dover – Wharton

NJMVC Regular Route File No. 1341(A) – Dover – Randolph

The emergency authority issued is subject to the following restrictions and conditions:

1. All stops on public highways are to be in conformity with N.J.S.A. 27:1A-44, N.J.S.A. 39:4-139 and N.J.S.A. 39:4-197.

2. Stops on private property shall be made only with the written permission of the property's owner. A copy of such written permission shall be filed with the Commission.
3. The Petitioner shall comply with all applicable requirements for commercial driver licenses (CDL's) with respect to drivers of its vehicles.
4. Petitioner must file Annual Reports regarding operations, usually in March for the preceding calendar year, must keep business records needed to complete the same, and must advise the Commission in writing of any change of address, phone number or registered agent.
5. Vehicles shall be presented for inspection every six months to the Commission, or more frequently if the Commission so deems. Petitioner is not permitted to participate in the self-inspection program with respect to these full inspections.
6. Petitioner or any commonly owned affiliate shall not engage in any activity inimical to the public interest in restraint of trade on routes and services under Commission jurisdiction or in interfering with lawfully authorized operations of other Commission-certified carriers.
7. If Petitioner shall fail to have the vehicles used in the for-hire services inspected and/or insured in accordance with N.J.S.A. Title 48, this authority shall become null and void.
8. Subfranchising of intrastate operating authority authorized by this emergency Certificate of Public Convenience and Necessity is prohibited, and any attempt to subfranchise shall be grounds for immediate suspension and/or revocation.
9. In addition to applicable regulatory requirements, vehicles shall be properly marked and signed, for the public interest, in accordance with any administrative order or directive of the Commission now or hereafter made, regarding Petitioner's vehicles.
10. Vehicles used for the intrastate operations authorized herein must be owned directly by the Petitioner or leased from a licensed leasing dealer. Under no circumstances may a vehicle be leased from a driver.
11. Drivers operating vehicles used in the intrastate autobus operations authorized herein must be employees of the Petitioner. Use of independent contract drivers to provide the intrastate autobus services is prohibited. Drivers must be under the direct control of Petitioner, who must be prepared to demonstrate through payroll records or other documentation on the request of the

Commission or a Commission inspector that all drivers are bona fide employees.

12. Petitioner shall advise the Commission in writing of all vehicles it uses for the authorized autobus operations, and shall update that listing as required by the Department. No other vehicles may be used in intrastate autobus operations pursuant to the emergency certificates. Before adding additional vehicles, Petitioner shall seek regulatory approval from the Commission.
13. Upon the demand of any official of the Commission, Petitioner shall present any and all vehicles for inspection, whether or not such vehicles are due for a regular inspection.
14. Drivers operating vehicles used in the intrastate autobus services authorized herein must possess the proper Commercial Driver License with Passenger Endorsement issued by the Commission.

You are directed to make contact immediately with the Commission's Commercial Bus Unit at (609) 777-4186 regarding operations of service and the inspection of vehicles. Operations are to be conducted under the laws, regulations and restrictions applicable to autobus service and under the provisions of the certificates that will issue. Satisfactory completion of the petition and related procedures is required.

This notice is not itself a certificate of public convenience and necessity; it does not vest any rights, and it is subject to cancellation, modification and retraction at any time. This letter notice shall be voided by subsequent action of the Commission with respect to the above docket or upon its expiration date of October 1, 2008.

This emergency authority is subject to immediate suspension for non-compliance with safety or insurance requirements. Opportunity for a hearing shall be provided thereafter regarding continued suspension and/or revocation.

Copies of this letter notice should be carried on all vehicles used in the service and shall be made available for inspection by officials of the Commission.
