NOTICE OF PUBLIC HEARING

The County of Morris will conduct two public hearings in accordance with N.J.S.A. 40A:12-13.5 et. seq. on a proposal to grant an easement, across County property to the New Jersey Department of Transportation to construct and maintain a bridge and/or associated approaches and roadways. The property in question is located on the County owned Dover and Rockaway Railroad in the Town of Dover and is listed in the tax records of the Town of Dover as Block 604, Lot 5.

In addition to the public hearings, the public is invited to submit written comments to the County on the granting of the easement to the New Jersey Department of Transportation no later than close of business day on June 6, 2008.
