Dear Mr. Laferrara:

On April 22, 2008, a Representative of the Department’s Bureau of Coastal and Land Use Compliance and Enforcement (“Bureau”) conducted an inspection of the above referenced site. The purpose of the inspection was to assess the outcome of the restoration work conducted at the Department's request. The inspection revealed that the restoration work, which required the removal of asphalt and crushed stone placed within the 150’ freshwater wetland transition area (buffer), has been completed as required. Additionally, the area of restoration has been seeded and covered with straw hay.

You have hereby satisfied the requirements contained in the Bureau's Notice of Violation, dated December 7, 2007, and this enforcement case is hereby resolved.

Be informed that any future disturbance or alteration of this area would constitute a State regulated and/or prohibited activity and require a permit authorization from the Department’s Division of Land Use Regulation (“DLUR”) prior to conducting such regulated activity. In addition, the Department reserves the right to take the appropriate enforcement action, including, but not limited to, the assessment of significant daily penalties, affixing the property deed, and/or the filing of a Superior Court injunction, should a State regulated and/or prohibited activity occur on the site without the necessary prior approvals.

Please be further advised that the newly restored area shall revert back to a natural meadow or hay field as per historic aerial photography. The Bureau will routinely monitor the restoration area to ensure that the current disturbance limits associated with parking and staging of materials and equipment are not expanded in any direction as much of the lower reaches of the property fall under the jurisdiction of the Freshwater Wetlands Protection Act (N.J.S.A. 13:9B-1 et seq.)
