











# Mt. Olive Recycling Center






**LOCATION:** Flanders-Drakestown Road, directly behind the Municipal Building  
**DAYS/HOURS OF OPERATION:** Monday through Friday: 8 a.m. – 12 noon; Saturday: 8 a.m. – 3 p.m.

**Recycling Center will be in operation 6 days a week WEATHER PERMITTING.**

1. Materials Accepted – Newspaper, mixed paper, junk mail, chip-board (i.e. cereal boxed), white paper board (i.e. dessert/cake boxes), corrugated boxes, glass beverage and food containers, aluminum food and beverage containers, steel and tin food containers, plastic pourable containers, automobile batteries, household batteries, anti-freeze, used motor oil, used oil filters. These materials are to be prepared in the same manner as if they were placed on the curb.
2. Leaves, brush and tires WILL NOT BE ACCEPTED at the recycling center. Curbside collection only. See inside for details.
3. If you do not know your collection day, have a question about recycling, or if you are not familiar with our current sticker program for appliances, furniture, tires, or for solid waste questions call the Sanitation Department at 973-691-0900 x361.

WHAT TO RECYCLE	HOW TO PREPARE
 <b>NEWSPAPERS</b>	Bundle Newspaper and cross tie with cord (no tape); stack newspapers no higher than one foot.
 <b>MAGAZINES</b>	Bundle magazines and cross tie with cord (no tape); stack magazines no higher than one foot.
 <b>MIXED PAPER</b>	Place mixed paper in brown paper bag. Mixed Paper includes: bond, computer and colored papers, envelopes, junk mail, fax paper, file folders and paper books. Can be combined with Chip-Board and white Paperboard.
 <b>GRAY/BROWN CHIP-BOARD</b>	Place Gray/Brown Chip-Board in a brown paper bag. Gray/Brown Chip-Board materials include: cereal, pizza, tissue, cracker/ cookie/gift boxes, notebook backings and gift wrap tubes. Can be mixed with chip-board, paper and white Paperboard.
 <b>BROWN PAPER BAGS</b>	Fold and place Brown Paper Bags into another brown paper bag.

WHAT TO RECYCLE	HOW TO PREPARE
 <b>CORRUGATED CARDBOARD</b>	Flatten, bundle and cross tie Corrugated Cardboard.
 <b>CO-MINGLE</b>	Place Co-Mingled items in one container on curb side. Remove all lids and caps. Be sure to rinse clean and empty completely (i.e. aerosol cans). Co-mingled recyclables include: plastic milk, water, soda bottles (identified by #1 & #2 on bottom of bottle) glass bottles & aluminum food & beverage containers, steel/tin containers and aerosol cans. No broken glass, window glass, mirrors, dish glass or light bulbs. No aluminum foil or pie plates. No yogurt, sour cream, cottage cheese, or butter tubs and no motor oil or antifreeze containers.
 <b>AUTOMOBILE BATTERIES</b>	Place Automobile Batteries on curb side with other recyclables.
 <b>HOUSEHOLD BATTERIES</b>	Place Household Batteries on curb side in ziplock bag or bring to Sanitation Department in the Municipal Building or to the Recycling Center. During hours of operation.
 <b>USED MOTOR OIL &amp; ANTIFREEZE</b>	Put Used Motor Oil and Antifreeze into sealed plastic jug; place with other recyclables.

WHAT TO RECYCLE	HOW TO PREPARE
 <b>USED OIL FILTERS</b>	Place Used Oil Filters at curb side in clear plastic or ziplock bag.
 <b>AUTOMOBILE TIRES</b>	Place Automobile Tires at curb with \$2.00 sticker per tire (purchase at Sanitation Department in Municipal Building). Collected January, March, May, July, September and November. <b>TIRES WILL NOT BE COLLECTED WITHOUT \$2.00 STICKER</b>
 <b>GRASS</b>	Cut Grass and leave it on lawn or place into brown paper bags that are sold by the township in various locations including the Sanitation Department at the Municipal Building and the Mt. Olive Public Library. Call for other locations. Collected from May 1st through October 2.
 <b>LEAVES</b>	Place Leaves in brown paper bags or rigid container. Brown paper bags are sold at various township locations including the Sanitation Department at the Municipal Building and the Mt. Olive Public Library. Call for other locations. Collected from mid-March through May 1st. Begins again from October through mid-December. Weather permitting.
 <b>BRUSH</b>	Bundle and tie Brush no longer than four (4) foot bundles. Brush will be collected from mid-March through May 1st. Begins again from October through mid-December. Weather permitting.
