HOUSEHOLD DUMPSTER (Allowed Items Up To 9 CU Yds for 2 weeks) \$260

- Household junk and those items requiring a sticker.
- Place large items on side of dumpster.
- Total items not to exceed the volume of the dumpster.
- Two full collection within 2 weeks of drop off
- * Township not responsible for damages caused to property during delivery/retrieval of containers.

HOUSEHOLD DUMPSTER EXCLUSIONS:

- Construction Debris, garbage, yard waste, paints, logs, curbside recyclable materials and hazardous waste.

CONSTRUCTION DEBRIS (Allowable Materials)

- Brick, sheetrock, concrete, wood, tile, roofing material and wooden sheds. Each container \$10; weight not to exceed 40 lbs. Two (2) container limit per collection day.

ALL LARGE ITEMS PLACED AT CURBSIDE MUST HAVE A STICKER FOR PICK UP.

Dear Property Owner:

Once again, the Township will continue the **Annual Large Item Clean Up** for residential property owners. In our effort to continually improve the delivery of our services and to make them more convenient for you, we have expanded the large item pick-up program, so that you have a greater window in which to perform your personal clean up and to dispose of the large bulk items.

Pick-up will be the last week during the months of April, May and June of 2005. Each resident may put out ONE item on the last solid waste pickup day of each of these months (total of THREE (3) items per residence).

WHAT YOU NEED TO KNOW:

- Place **ACCEPTABLE** household item curb side by 5:00 a.m. on your scheduled pick up day. (Do not place item out more than one day prior to collection.)
- If we are unable to collect this material on the day scheduled due to weather or equipment problems, we will pick them up the following day. There is no need to call our office.
- Review the following list of acceptable items to determine eligibility for pick-up.

We are very pleased that we are able to continue to offer this valued service to our residents. ACCEPTABLE ITEMS

All furniture (such as): sofa, love seat, kitchen table and miscellaneous small pieces. Mattresses/box springs, carpet (cut and tied), small toys bagged or large toys, metal sheds (cut and tied), barbecue grills, disassembled swing sets and/or metal railings.
*METAL ITEMS: *Washers, dryers, stoves, hot water heaters, Dishwashers, riding mowers, lawn mowers.

UNACCEPTABLE ITEMS

Explosives, radioactive materials, all appliances and metal goods such as refrigerators, freezers, air conditioners, oil/propane tanks, tires/rim, leaves, brush, grass, concrete, asphalt, bricks, dirt, paints, construction materials, computers, printers, and/or hazardous materials. These items can be disposed of through the normal Township sticker program

ASBESTOS, INSULATION, SIDING

- Over 100 lbs, contact licensed asbestos hauler.

SMOKE DETECTORS

- Contact manufacturer for proper disposal
