

## Mt Olive Recreation Shawnee Ski Program 2010

Dear Parents/Guardians of Shawnee Ski/Snowboarders,

As January 8<sup>th</sup> approaches quickly I would like to take the time to thank you for involving your child in our Shawnee Ski/snowboard program. The children will have a great time!! There are a few things you need to know to help insure the safety of your child.

All children need to be dropped off and picked up at Turkey Brook Park. The buses arrive at 4:00pm; please do not drop your child off before then. Please do not stop in the entrance of the parking lot or on the loop road. This causes traffic jams and is unsafe for children and drivers. The buses depart to Shawnee at 4:30pm and return at 11:00pm.

If your child has equipment (ski's, snowboard, helmet, etc.), please label it with their names. Please remind your child to be responsible with his/her equipment (including rentals).

Helmets are **mandatory** for **all** Participants, wrist guards are **mandatory** for **snowboarders**.

To keep your child's things safe, lockers are available at Shawnee Mountain; the cost is 75 cents per entry into locker (sending quarters will make things easier for your child). Additional money will be needed for the snack bar (Skiing/snowboarding makes you hungry!!!).

All participants will be required to ride the bus **to Shawnee and they must ride it back from Shawnee**. Parents are welcome to come and join their children at Shawnee, but will have to follow the bus back to Turkey Brook Park to pick up their children from the bus. For your child's safety and well-being this policy will be enforced. We understand emergencies and situations do arise. If you have a special need it must be cleared thru Recreation.
