ORDINANCE AMENDING SECTION 3(e)(ii) OF BOND
ORDINANCE #7-2022, AS AMENDED BY ORDINANCE #1-
2023 AND ORDINANCE #18-2023, OF THE TOWNSHIP OF
MOUNT OLIVE, IN THE COUNTY OF MORRIS, NEW
JERSEY, FINALLY ADOPTED APRIL 5, 2022, AS
AMENDED JANUARY 24, 2023 AND JUNE 27, 2023, IN
ORDER TO INCLUDE ADDITIONAL PROJECTS.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE TOWNSHIP COUNCIL OF THE TOWNSHIP OF
MOUNT OLIVE, IN THE COUNTY OF MORRIS, NEW JERSEY (not less than two-thirds
of all members thereof affirmatively concurring) AS FOLLOWS:

Section One. Section 3(e)(ii) of Bond Ordinance #7-2022, as amended by
Ordinance #01-2023 and Ordinance #18-2023, of the Township of Mount Olive, in the
County of Morris, New Jersey (the "Township"), finally adopted April 5, 2022, as amended
January 24, 2023 and June 27, 2023 ("Bond Ordinance #7-2022"), is hereby amended to
include the acquisition of general emergency medical services and general fire equipment
for all Fire and Emergency Medical Services volunteer groups and to read as follows:

"(e)(ii) Replacement of Engine 53 and the acquisition of pages for Budd
Lake Fire Department, radios for Flanders Rescue Squad, radios, pagers
and an ultra-violet light for Budd Lake Rescue Squad and the acquisition of
emergency medical services and general fire equipment for all Fire and
Emergency Medical Services volunteer groups, including all related costs
and expenditures incidental thereto."


Section Two. The Township hereby certifies that it has adopted a capital budget
or a temporary capital budget, as applicable. The capital or temporary capital budget of
the Township is hereby amended to conform with the provisions of this ordinance to the

extent of any inconsistency herewith. To the extent that the purposes authorized herein are inconsistent with the adopted capital or temporary capital budget, a revised capital or temporary capital budget has been filed with the Division of Local Government Services.

Section Three. This ordinance shall take effect 20 days after the first publication thereof after final adoption, as provided by the Local Bond Law.
