## ORD.#9-2024

## AN ORDINANCE OF THE TOWNSHIP OF MOUNT OLIVE, COUNTY OF MORRIS, STATE OF NEW JERSEY, AMENDING SECTION 550-23, ZONING PERMITS AND CERTIFICATES OF OCCUPANCY; FEES, OF THE TOWNSHIP CODE TO REQUIRE CERTAIN ESCROW FEES

**WHEREAS**, the Township Planning Director has recommended that the Township require an escrow fee in certain circumstances when stormwater management measures, such as drywell for a single-family home, are mandated by Chapter 550 of the Township Code; and

WHEREAS, the Township Council wishes to adopt the recommendation and amend the Code accordingly.

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED** by the Township Council of the Township of Mount Olive, County of Morris, State of New Jersey, as follows:

**SECTION 1.** Chapter 550, Land Use, § 550-23, Zoning permits and certificates of occupancy; fees, of the Township Code is hereby amended to add new paragraph F to read as follows:

- F. An escrow fee of \$500 shall be submitted if the zoning permit requires review by the Township Engineer for compliance with Township stormwater regulations as set forth in §550-73, Stormwater Management of the Land Use Code.
- **SECTION 2.** Ordinances, resolutions, regulations or parts of ordinances, resolutions and regulations inconsistent herewith are hereby repealed to the extent of such inconsistencies.
- **SECTION 3.** If any section, subsection, sentence, clause or phrase of this Ordinance is for any reason held to be unconstitutional or invalid by a court of competent jurisdiction, such a decision shall not affect the remaining portions of this Ordinance.
- **SECTION 4.** This Ordinance shall take effect twenty (20) days following final passage, approval, and publication as required by law.
