ORDINANCE APPROPRIATING \$224,180 FROM AN

AWARD FROM THE STATE OF NEW JERSEY FOR THE

ACQUISITION OF BODY WORN CAMERAS IN AND BY

THE TOWNSHIP OF MOUNT OLIVE, IN THE COUNTY OF

MORRIS, NEW JERSEY.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE TOWNSHIP COUNCIL OF THE TOWNSHIP OF

MOUNT OLIVE, IN THE COUNTY OF MORRIS, NEW JERSEY AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. \$224,180 is hereby appropriated by the Township of Mount Olive, in

the County of Morris, New Jersey (the "Township") from an award from the State of New

Jersey for the acquisition of body worn cameras, including all related costs and

expenditures incidental thereto.

Section 2. The Township hereby certifies that it has adopted a capital budget or a

Section 3. This ordinance shall take effect after final adoption and publication and

otherwise as provided by law.
