AN ORDINANCE OF THE TOWNSHIP OF MOUNT OLIVE, IN THE COUNTY OF MORRIS AND STATE OF NEW JERSEY, AMENDING CHAPTER 318, SEWER AND WATER, OF THE TOWNSHIP CODE TO PERMIT INSTALLATION OF IRRIGATION SYSTEMS IN DEVELOPMENTS IN THE MORRIS CHASE WATER SYSTEM SERVICE AREA

WHEREAS, due to a limited water supply and potential for additional development, the Township of Mount Olive ("Township") had previously prohibited the installation of irrigation systems within the Morris Chase Water System service area, in accordance with Section 318-32 of the Township Code; and

WHEREAS, the Township is now in a position to permit installation of irrigation systems within the Morris Chase Water System service area, with certain restrictions.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the Township Council of the Township of Mount Olive, in the County of Morris and State of New Jersey, as follows:

SECTION 1. Chapter 318, Sewers and Water, Part 1, General Provisions, Article V, Conservation of Water, is hereby amended to add new § 318-35, Irrigation Systems, to read as follows:

"§ 318-35 Irrigation Systems.

Irrigation systems may be installed in any development serviced by the Morris Chase Water System, including. but not limited to, Morris Chase, Morris Hunt, Goldmine, and Lynwood developments. However, irrigation systems may operate only on an every-other-day basis, with odd-numbered houses watering on odd-numbered days and even-numbered houses operating on even-numbered days."

SECTION 2. This Ordinance may be renumbered for the purposes of Codification.

SECTION 3. If any section, subsection, clause, or phrase of this Ordinance is for any reason held to be unconstitutional or invalid by any court of competent jurisdiction, such decision shall not affect the remaining portions of the Ordinance.

SECTION 4. All ordinances or parts of ordinances of the Township of Mount Olive that are inconsistent herewith are repealed to the extent of such inconsistency.

SECTION 5. This Ordinance shall take effect twenty (20) days following final passage, approval, and publication as required by law.
