ORDINANCE AMENDING SECTION 3(e) OF BOND ORDINANCE #10-2015 OF THE TOWNSHIP OF MOUNT OLIVE, IN THE COUNTY OF MORRIS, NEW JERSEY, FINALLY ADOPTED MARCH 17, 2015 IN ORDER TO AMEND THE DESCRIPTION OF THE PROJECT.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE TOWNSHIP COUNCIL OF THE TOWNSHIP OF MOUNT OLIVE, IN THE COUNTY OF MORRIS, NEW JERSEY (not less than two-thirds of all members thereof affirmatively concurring) AS FOLLOWS:

Section One. Section 3(e) of Bond Ordinance #10-2015 of the Township of Mount Olive, in the County of Morris, New Jersey (the "Township"), finally adopted March 17, 2015 ("Bond Ordinance #10-2015"), is amended to include the Pershing Estates Water Installation Project as follows:

"e) Installation of a water tower low water alarm system and the Pershing Estates Water Installation Project, consisting of the joining of the Pine Crest water system and the Morris Chase/Tinc water system by running an interconnection through Pershing Estates, including all work and materials necessary therefor and incidental thereto."

Section Two. All other details of Bond Ordinance #10-2015 remain as originally adopted.

Section Three. The Township hereby certifies that it has adopted a capital budget or a temporary capital budget, as applicable. The capital or temporary capital budget of the Township is hereby amended to conform with the provisions of this ordinance to the extent of any inconsistency herewith. To the extent that the purposes authorized herein are inconsistent with the adopted capital or temporary capital budget, a revised capital or temporary capital budget has been filed with the Division of Local Government Services.

Section Four. This ordinance shall take effect 20 days after the first publication thereof after final adoption, as provided by the Local Bond Law.
