## ORD#28-2018

## AN ORDINANCE OF THE TOWNSHIP OF MOUNT OLIVE, IN THE COUNTY OF MORRIS AND STATE OF NEW JERSEY, AMENDING CHAPTER 102, ALARM SYSTEMS, OF THE TOWNSHIP CODE TO REMOVE THE REQUIREMENT TO REGISTER WITH THE TOWNSHIP

- WHEREAS, Chapter 102, Alarm Systems, of the Code of the Township of Mount Olive requires alarm owners to register with the Township; and
- **WHEREAS**, alarm owners now register directly with private alarm monitoring centers so that registration with the Township is unnecessary and burdensome.
- **NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED** by the Township Council of the Township of Mount Olive, in the County of Morris and State of New Jersey, as follows:
- **SECTION 1.** Chapter 102, Alarm Systems, § 102-2, Definitions, is hereby amended to delete the definition of "Registrant" in its entirety.
- **SECTION 2.** Chapter 102, Alarm Systems, § 102-3, Registration required, is hereby deleted in its entirety.
- **SECTION 3.** Chapter 102, Alarm Systems, § 102-4, Alarms, paragraph A, is hereby deleted in its entirety.
  - **SECTION 4.** Chapter 102, Alarm Systems, § 102-9, Fees, is hereby deleted in its entirety.
- **SECTION 5.** Chapter 102, Alarm Systems, § 102-10, Violations and penalties, paragraph B, is hereby amended to read as follows:
- Each false alarm after the two warnings shall each be fined \$50 per activation in any given calendar year.
- **SECTION 6.** If any section, subsection, clause, or phrase of this Ordinance is for any reason held to be unconstitutional or invalid by any court of competent jurisdiction, such decision shall not affect the remaining portions of the Ordinance.
- **SECTION 7.** All ordinances or parts of ordinances of the Township of Mount Olive that are inconsistent herewith are repealed to the extent of such inconsistency.
  - **SECTION 8**. This Ordinance may be renumbered for purposes of codification.
- **SECTION 9.** This Ordinance shall take effect twenty (20) days following final passage, approval, and publication as required by law.
