BOND ORDINANCE AMENDING BOND ORDINANCE NUMBERED 11-2014 OF THE TOWNSHIP OF MOUNT OLIVE, IN THE COUNTY OF MORRIS, NEW JERSEY, FINALLY ADOPTED APRIL 22, 2014, TO REVISE THE SECOND PARAGRAPH OF SECTION 3(j) THEREOF IN ORDER TO INCLUDE ADDITIONAL PROJECTS AND TO REDUCE THE USEFUL LIFE OF SAID PROJECTS AND TO REVISE SECTION 6(b) THEREOF IN ORDER TO AMEND THE AVERAGE USEFUL LIFE OF THE PROJECTS BEING FINANCED BY SAID BOND ORDINANCE.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE TOWNSHIP COUNCIL OF THE TOWNSHIP OF MOUNT OLIVE, IN THE COUNTY OF MORRIS, NEW JERSEY (not less than two-thirds of all members thereof affirmatively concurring), AS FOLLOWS:

Section One. The second paragraph of Section 3(j) of Bond Ordinance numbered 11-2014 of the Township of Mount Olive, in the County of Morris, New Jersey (the "Township"), finally adopted April 22, 2014 ("Bond Ordinance #11-2014"), is hereby amended in its entirety to include additional projects and to reduce the useful life to read as follows:

"Acquisition of a generator<sup>(2)</sup>, replacement of mowers, the completion of a public safety simulcast radio infrastructure and 911 upgrades, including all related costs and expenditures incidental thereto and further including all work and materials necessary therefor and incidental thereto.

\$330,000<sup>(2)</sup> \$228,000 10 years"

Section Two. Section 6(b) of Bond Ordinance #11-2014 is hereby amended in its entirety to read as follows:

"The average period of usefulness, computed on the basis of the respective amounts of obligations authorized for each purpose and the reasonable life thereof within the limitations of the Local Bond Law, is 10.84 years."

Section Three. The Township hereby certifies that it has adopted a capital budget or a temporary capital budget, as applicable. The capital or temporary capital budget of the Township is hereby amended to conform with the provisions of this bond ordinance to the extent of any inconsistency herewith. To the extent that the purposes authorized herein are inconsistent with the adopted capital or temporary capital budget, a revised capital or temporary capital budget has been filed with the Division of Local Government Services.

Section Four. This bond ordinance shall take effect 20 days after the first publication thereof after final adoption, as provided by the Local Bond Law.
