ORDINANCE APPROPRIATING \$124,560 FROM COUNTY

GRANTS AND OPEN SPACE FOR PART 1 AND PART 2 OF THE STABILIZATION OF THE SEWARD HOUSE IN AND

BY THE TOWNSHIP OF MOUNT OLIVE, IN THE COUNTY

OF MORRIS, NEW JERSEY

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE TOWNSHIP COUNCIL OF THE TOWNSHIP OF

MOUNT OLIVE, IN THE COUNTY OF MORRIS, NEW JERSEY AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. \$124,560 is hereby appropriated, \$103,800 of which is being funded from

County Grants and \$20,760 of which is being funded from Open Space, for Part 1 and Part 2 of

the stabilization of the Seward House in and by the Township of Mount Olive, in the County of

Morris, New Jersey (the "Township"), including all work and materials, necessary therefor and

incidental thereto.

Section 2. The Township hereby certifies that it has adopted a capital budget or a

temporary capital budget, as applicable. The capital or temporary capital budget of the Township

is hereby amended to conform with the provisions of this ordinance to the extent of any

inconsistency herewith. To the extent that the purposes authorized herein are inconsistent with

the adopted capital or temporary capital budget, a revised capital or temporary capital budget has

been filed with the Division of Local Government Services.

Section 3. This ordinance shall take effect after final adoption and publication and

otherwise as provided by law.
