AN ORDINANCE OF THE TOWNSHIP OF MOUNT OLIVE, IN THE COUNTY OF MORRIS, STATE OF NEW JERSEY, SETTING THE SPEED LIMIT ON COREY ROAD AT 25 MILES PER HOUR [TO BE INCORPORATED INTO CHAPTER 245 OF THE MOUNT OLIVE TOWNSHIP CODE

WHEREAS, the Township's Engineer has recommended a reduction in the speed limit on Corey Road for the safety of the Township's residents.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the Township Council of the Township of Mount Olive, in the County of Morris, State of New Jersey as follows:

Chapter 245 of the Mount Olive Township Code entitled, "Vehicles and Traffic" is hereby amended to incorporate the following:

SECTION 1. Commencing August 1, 2012, the speed limit for Corey Road shall cease being 35 miles per hour, and shall henceforth be 25 miles per hour for the entire length of Corey Road.

SECTION 2. If any section, subsection, clause or phrase of this ordinance is for any reason held to be unconstitutional or invalid by any court or competent jurisdiction, such decision shall not affect the remaining portion of this ordinance.

SECTION 3. This ordinance may be renumbered for purposes of codification.
