## ORDINANCE#27-2012

ORDINANCE AMENDING SECTION 1 OF ORDINANCE

NUMBERED 34-2011 OF THE TOWNSHIP OF MOUNT

OLIVE, IN THE COUNTY OF MORRIS, NEW JERSEY,

FINALLY ADOPTED DECEMBER 20, 2011 IN ORDER TO

AMEND THE SOURCE OF THE FUNDING

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE TOWNSHIP COUNCIL OF THE TOWNSHIP OF MOUNT OLIVE, IN THE COUNTY OF MORRIS, NEW JERSEY (not less than two-thirds of all members thereof affirmatively concurring) AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1 of Ordinance numbered 34-2011 of the Township of Mount Olive, in the County of Morris, New Jersey (the "Township"), finally adopted December 20, 2011 is amended to read as follows:

"Section 1. "\$90,000 is hereby appropriated, \$45,000 of which will be funded from the Open Space Trust Fund and \$45,000 of which will be funded from a Green Acres grant, for the acquisition of property located at 191 Flanders-Drakestown Road, Flanders, New Jersey, as more specifically described as Block 7801, Lot 13 on the tax maps of the Township, including all related costs and expenditures incidental thereto."

Section 2. The Township hereby certifies that it has adopted a capital budget or a temporary capital budget, as applicable. The capital or temporary capital budget of the Township is hereby amended to conform with the provisions of this ordinance to the extent of any inconsistency herewith. To the extent that the purposes authorized herein are inconsistent with the adopted capital or temporary capital budget, a revised capital or temporary capital budget has been filed with the Division of Local Government Services.

Section 3. This ordinance shall take effect 20 days after the first publication thereof after final adoption, as provided by the Local Bond Law.
